POLICY on energy efficiency modernization of buildings

1. GENERAL TERMS

- 1.1. This policy has been developed for implementation at the Moscow State University of Food Production (hereinafter MSUFP, the University).
- 1.2. The University takes responsibility for modernizing the existing University buildings in a more energy-efficient manner.
- 1.3. The University has developed a set of measures aimed at modernizing the campus's energy efficiency.

2. SET OF MEASURES

- 2.1. MSUFP conducts studies on the existing energy capacity system efficiency.
- 2.2. MSUFP studies examples of the district heat grids rational operation.
- 2.3. The University intends to increase energy efficiency, to use efficient materials for repairs, construction, and reconstruction, which can reduce heat losses by two to three times.
 - 2.4. The University takes care of the heat saving during heating of the building.
- 2.5. In order to improve the energy efficiency of building technical systems, MSUFP aims at:
- 2.5.1. carrying out mandatory surveys on the heat protection quality of the capital construction final product with the heat-energy passport issuance;
 - 2.5.2. development of standards for heating, hot water and cold water supplies;
- 2.5.3. development of internal recommendations for the design and construction of buildings with modern heating, ventilation and heating systems.
